

Eurail Select Pass fact sheet



A Eurail Select Pass gives you the choice of 3, 4 or 5 of the following 24 countries to explore.

The 24 participating Eurail Select countries are: **Austria; Benelux; Bulgaria; Serbia & Montenegro; Croatia/Slovenia; Czech Republic; Denmark; Finland; France; Germany; Greece; Hungary; Italy; Norway; Portugal; Republic of Ireland; Romania; Spain; Sweden; Switzerland.** (Liechtenstein and Monaco are considered part of Austria and France respectively). A day of rail travel is a 24 hour period from midnight to midnight. This allows for unlimited travel on any number of trains for each day of use. The days do not have to be used consecutively.

Extra information

Inclusions:

- **Unlimited** travel on the national rail networks of any 3, 4 or 5 adjoining Eurail countries that are connected by train or ship (see explanation below).
- The 22 participating Eurail Select countries are: **Austria; Benelux; Bulgaria; Serbia & Montenegro; Croatia/Slovenia; Czech Republic; Denmark; Finland; France; Germany; Greece; Hungary; Italy; Norway; Portugal; Republic of Ireland; Romania; Spain; Sweden; Switzerland.** (Liechtenstein and Monaco are considered part of Austria and France respectively).
- **Validity** : 5, 6, 8, 10 or 15 days within 2 months. Note: 15 day pass only available for 5 country pass.
- Travel days may be used consecutively or non-consecutively.
- 1st Class (Youth Pass 2nd class only).
- **Saverpass**: valid for 2-5 people travelling together at all times. Approx. 15% reduction off regular price.
- **Youth Pass**: under 26 years of age.
- **Children 4-11yrs** inclusive: half adult fare.
- **Children under 4yrs**: free when sharing a paying passenger's seat/ bed.
- What are adjoining Countries?
- The chosen countries must be bordering, and be linked by a direct (not through another country) train or shipping line which is part of the existing Eurail offer. E.g. France, Benelux and Germany are three adjoining countries.
- Norway and Denmark are connected by the Color Line Boat connection Hirtshals- Kristiansand. You can add one more connecting country to your Selectpass, like Sweden or Germany.
- Belgium/ Netherlands/ Luxembourg are considered as one country called Benelux.
- Serbia & Montenegro are considered as one country.
- Croatia/ Slovenia are considered as one country.
- **Important!** Norway and Finland are not considered as adjoining countries. They have a joint border, but to get by train from Norway to Finland you have to pass through Sweden

Bonuses

Ferry crossings between :

- Greece & Italy: boats crossing Brindisi-Corfu-Igoumenitsa-Patras operated by HML or Blue Star Ferries are included when the pass is valid for travel in Italy and Greece. A summer surcharge must be paid from June 10 to September 30. Reservations are recommended in July and August.
- Finland & Sweden: boats crossing Helsinki-Mariehamn-Stockholm; Turku-Mariehamn-Stockholm; Vasa-Umea (operated by Silja Line) are included when the pass is valid for travel in Finland and Sweden. Reservations are recommended from June to August.
- Finland & Germany: boats crossing Rostock-Helsinki are included when the pass is valid for travel in Finland and Germany.

Note

Free Bonus Offers may necessitate usage of a Day on the Pass.

Please note the private line between Naples and Sorrento is NOT covered by the Eurail Pass.

Conditions

- Residents of Europe, the United Kingdom, Turkey and the Russian Federation are not eligible to purchase or use a Eurail Select Pass.
- If you have been working/residing or traveling in Europe for 6 months or more you are not eligible to travel with a Eurail Pass.
- Countries do not have to be travelled to in the same order as they appear on the pass. It is not compulsory to travel to all countries listed on your rail pass and you may also travel to a country more than once. EG. If the pass is valid in France, Italy & Switzerland the passenger can travel from France to Italy then back to France if they wish.
- All parties must be present when validating a Eurail Select Saver Pass
- Certain trains may transit through a country not covered by the pass. In that case an additional ticket must be purchased.
- Passholder fares for Premier trains are not applicable if the train is transiting through a country not covered by the Eurail Select Pass.
- Passes must be validated prior to first train journey or first use of a travel bonus.
- Passes must be validated within 6 months of issue date.
- Seat reservation fees are an additional charge and are not inclusive in the cost of the pass.
- What is the 7pm rule?
 - If your train departs before 19.00 hrs (7 pm), you need to use two travel days
 - If you are travelling on a direct night train (with no connections or layovers) that departs after 19.00 hrs (7 pm) and arrives after 04.00 hrs (4 am), you only need to use one day - the day of arrival.Please note: your Pass must be valid on the day of departure and arrival.

Refunds

- Passes must be presented for refund unused and not validated.
- A 25% cancellation fee plus GST (only in Australia) applies to totally unused passes returned within one year of issuing date.
- No partial refunds.
- Eurail Select Passes cannot be reissued if lost or stolen.
