This shows more details of the 0742 journey with one change. This includes where to change, how long between trains and whether the train is compulsory to reserve or not.

You can also click these links to see a map of the route the train takes, or see all stops made by the train along the way.

SOME TIPS FOR DEPARTURE/ARRIVAL STATIONS:

Sometimes you may find that the English word for a town does not appear on the website and the option it gives you makes no sense at all! The timetable will always show European Spellings so as long as you correctly spell a town name in English it will automatically show the corresponding European spelling when the train times appear. However in some instances this is not the case and to assist you with this we have listed the spelling you will need to use.

Brussels- Bruxelles-Midi (This station is used by all high speed and Eurostar trains.)

Ypres- Ieper

Tours- Tours (central to CBD) OR St Pierre Des Corps. Tours is closer to the CBD however St Pierre Des Corps is often used for TGV services.

Copenhagen- Kobenhavn

Gothenberg- Goeteborg

Munich - Munchen

Geneva - Geneve

Venice - Venezia Mestre (On the mainland)

Venice - Venezia Santa Lucia (on the island of Venice and the major tourist destination)

Porto Fino - S.Margherita Ligure. There is no station in Portofino but this is the closest station and only a few kms by bus or taxi.

Cinque Terre - There are many railway stations along the coastline, these include Levanto, Monterosso, Vernazza & La Spezia. Your hotel will be able to tell you which one is closest to where you need to go.

Sorrento - Will not appear in the timetable because this is a privately owned line and we cannot sell tickets or passes which include Sorrento or anywhere on the Amalfi Coast.

Dubrovnik - There is no train line here- Look up the train to Split then purchase a local bus ticket to Dubrovnik.

Bucharest - Bucuresti

Belgrade - Beograd

Genoa - Genova

Turin - Torino

Greek cities are no longer available to look up through DB Bahn timetable site. Due to Greece not releasing trains into the International Reservation System, we can only issue point to point tickets for trains within Greece.

A great advantage of rail travel in Europe is that there are a large number of stations located at Airports throughout Europe. If you wish to depart from one of these airport stations it will be necessary to type the word "airport" or "flughafen" after the city name.

I.e. To catch a train from Frankfurt Airport instead of the city you should type "Frankfurt flughafen"

We hope the above assists in using this timetable to plan your rail travel throughout Europe.
