

Use one single pass combining **England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland**, to visit exciting cities like London, Cardiff, Edinburgh and Dublin, or choose less travelled routes including Irish attractions such as Cork and the Mountains of Mourne.

The Britrail plus Ireland Pass is a Flexi Pass valid for any 5 or 10 days unlimited travel within a 1 month period. Travel days may be used consecutively or non consecutively

A day of rail travel is a 24 hour period from midnight to midnight. This allows for unlimited travel on any number of trains for each day of use

General information

Each further day of travel must be entered on your pass before you board the train.

To start using the pass it must be validated at a British train station before your first journey.

This pass does not cover the London Underground

Extra information

Inclusions:

- The Britrail Pass Plus Ireland is valid for travel on the railway network of Great Britain (England, Scotland and Wales) plus Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland.
- It is valid for travel on the following London Airport Link services: Heathrow Express Gatwick Express Stansted Express (Stansted Sky Train). Note: travel on the Heathrow Express or Gatwick Express will constitute a travel day of the pass.
- Special passholder fare available on Eurostar.

Special Offers

- Other children 5-15 years inclusive travel at half the adult price.
- Other children under 5 years travel free if not occupying a seat / bed.

Conditions

- Residents of the United Kingdom and Ireland are not eligible to purchase or use a Britrail Pass Plus Ireland.
 - Passes must be validated within 6 months of issue date.
 - Passes must be validated prior to boarding the first train.
 - Passes are actual documents and do not need to be exchanged.
 - Reservation fees are an additional charge and not inclusive in the cost of the pass.
 - What is the 7pm rule?
 - If your train departs before 19.00 hrs (7 pm), you need to use two travel days
 - If you are travelling on a direct night train (with no connections or layovers) that departs after 19.00 hrs (7 pm) and arrives after 04.00 hrs (4 am), you only need to use one day (the day of arrival).
- Please note: your Pass must be valid on the day of departure and arrival.

Refunds

- Britrail Pass Plus Ireland must be presented unused and not validated for refund.
- A 25% cancellation fee plus GST (only in Australia) applies to totally unused passes and not validated passes returned within 6 months of issue date.
