

If you're planning to be based in London or the Southeast of England this is the ideal Pass. The Britrail London Plus Pass is the convenient way to see the south east of England. Frolic by the sea of Brighton, walk with Majesty at Windsor or soak up the intellectual atmosphere of Oxford and Cambridge.

The Britrail London Plus Pass is a Flexi Pass valid for unlimited travel for any 2 or 4 days travel within 8 days, or any 7 days within 15 days. Travel days may be used consecutively or non consecutively.

A day of rail travel is a 24 hour period from midnight to midnight. This allows for unlimited travel on any number of trains for each day of use.

Extended Boundaries

In order to deliver a greater value experience, the boundaries of the Britrail London Plus Pass now include Bath, Bristol and Stratford-Upon-Avon.

General information

To start using the pass it must be validated at a British train station before your first journey.

Each further day of travel must be entered on your pass before you board the train.

This pass does not cover the London Underground

Extra information

Inclusions:

- The Britrail London Plus Pass is valid for travel on the participating train operators services in the South East area of England surrounding London (a detailed map is available on the Britrail Ticket cover)
- The Boundary Stations of the London Plus Pass are: Harwich, Kings Lynn, Huntingdon, Bedford, Long Buckby, Stratford-upon-Avon, Worcester Foregate Street, Bedwyn, Salisbury, Bristol Temple Meads and Weymouth.
- Not valid on Great Western trains
- The Britrail London Plus Pass now includes 2 extra coupons valid on the Heathrow Express, Stansted Express or Gatwick Express
- Coupons do not need to be used on same airport express. Travel on the Airport Expresses does not use a day's travel on the Pass. Simply redeem the coupons for travel.

Conditions

- Age 5 and under travel for free if not occupying a seat or bed.
- Ages 5-15 qualify for child fares (50% off the adult fare).
- Permanent residents of the UK are not eligible to purchase or use a Britrail London Plus Pass.
- Passes must be validated within 6 months of issue date.
- Passes are actual travel documents and do not need to be exchanged, and must be validated prior to boarding the first train.
- Any onward journey made outside the Britrail London Plus Pass area boundary must be paid in advance before boarding the relevant train i.e: a valid ticket must be purchased, otherwise penalty fees will be incurred.
- Reservation fees are an additional charge and not inclusive in the cost of the pass.
- 7:00pm rule does not apply.

Refunds

- Britrail London Plus Pass must be presented unused and not validated for refund.
- A 25% cancellation fee plus GST (only in Australia) applies to totally unused and not validated passes returned within 6 months of issue date.
